

ValueWest Assessor Family Scholarship 2018

Anticipated Award \$2500

To be used during the 2018 calendar year for tuition.

Eligibility: Any dependent child between the ages of 17 and 25 of a Colorado County Assessor or a current County Assessor employee who has been employed there for at least five consecutive years.

Required: High School Diploma or GED must be obtained no later than July 1, 2018. Demonstration of some public service or participation in extracurricular activities in High School (i.e. Sports, Speech and Debate, Student Government, Church Groups, Clubs, etc.....)

Qualifying Institutions: Any post high school institution listed on the U.S. Department of Education Database of Accredited Postsecondary Institutions and Programs. The list of Accredited Institutions is available at ope.ed.gov/accreditation.

Criteria: The award decision will be made by a volunteer committee of three or four Colorado County Assessor's based on the following criteria (the scholarship donors will have no role in determining the recipient other than to define the standards by which the award is evaluated.)

1. Does the applicant meet the minimum requirements? Yes or No
2. Question: How will this scholarship help you to accomplish your educational goals? <250 Words
3. Question: How are you a good example to your peers, siblings or community? <250 words
4. Question: Write a 250 word Essay based on the following topic: "I have 20 hours and a thousand dollars to spend on someone else".
5. Describe your participation in community, church or school activities.

Completed applications must be emailed or postmarked by April 1, 2018. Email attachments must be in PDF format. Applicants are responsible for making sure that the application is both sent and received on a timely basis. The recipient will be named at the 2018 Colorado Assessor's Association Summer Conference.
